Through practical lessons, preceded by theoretical introductions, this course aims to achieve the following outcomes: Proficiency in fundamental voice recording techniques: in the studio, on location, live, and in editing. Utilization of professional microphones: XLR type, lavalier microphones, and digital recorders - Fundamental utilization of DAW software and plug-ins for editing and correcting sound and voice errors: sound restoration

Knowledge and understanding	- fundamental understanding of the functions of sound in a podcast product; Utilizing sound design and music to accentuate moments of varying emotional intensity within the podcast.
